## **Summer Camp for Asian, European and American Primary and Secondary School Students**

- **Camp Activities**

The planned activities include Chinese Language Class, Chinese Opera and Kongfu experiencing, Chinese traditional skills practicing, visits to cultural landscape and venues, Chinese art appreciation and Chinese cuisine tasting. Priority is given to interactive and participative sports & cultural activities among students from different continents and countries.

- **Activity Design**

Participants of different language and cultural background fall into 15 teams and will be assigned specific tasks (such as martial arts learning, Peking opera performance, painting of facial makeup in operas, speaking Chinese and so on) . The teams compete and participants from all countries participate. A winner team and individual will be chosen and awarded certificate.

- **Scale**

150 primary and secondary school students (15 Confucius Institutes, 10 for each) ;

- **Language**

Chinese & English (providing language service including German, French, Italian, Polish, Hungarian, Czech, Bulgarian, Spanish, Korean and Malay languages)

- **Fees**

The program covers the accommodation and boarding, transportation, insurance (accident insurance), Chinese classes and sightseeing fees for all participants and guiding teachers on July 18-24.

- **Participant Enrollment**

1. Qualification: aged between 12-18, in good health conditions and with a foreign nationality. Preference is given to those who have never been to China.
2. Selection: CIs can select participants through competition or defined standards.
3. Registration: CIs send, to the program office, the final list of participants and foreign guiding teachers before Mar. 31, 2010. (The program office will offer a uniformed list to all CIs.)
4. Warming-up: CIs organize the enrolled participants and teachers to prepare 1-2 group shows (e.g. Chinese song singing, Chinese dancing, Chinese Kongfu, drama, etc.), and to get acquainted with each other.
